- Robust 2/4-line alphanumeric pager with charging-base
- Specially designed for truck drivers
- Easy to use, easily readable display

The robust two or four-line alphanumeric pager, model type AK500, with its illuminated display does not require the expensive trouble of changing the battery – it is simply recharged on a charging base.

The AK500 has been specially designed for truck drivers and is easy to use. The device is operated by a single button which pressed by the driver for the sole purpose of reading messages. This virtually eliminates any possibility of using the device incorrectly.

The pager also only saves the most recent and current message. This means that the driver only ever sees "his" messages intended for him alone. Instructions are clear and unmistakable displayed in large easily readable characters, "BAY 5" or "GATE 77", for instance.

If the dispatcher inadvertently sends the wrong ramp number, or if there are changes at short notice, the old message is automatically overwritten by the updated information. The message remains in the display of the pager until the driver returns the device and is only automatically deleted through a reset function when the device is attached to the charging base.

The charging base is also the place where the pagers are kept. Once charged up, the pagers are ready for use and can be handed out again. Depending on the frequency of the alerts, the battery has a life of up to 3 days. The pagers should, however, always be recharged at the charging base.
